

Makaton Foundation Course

Overview

This course is recommended for professionals who need to use Makaton in their work and people who require a more in-depth training. You start with the Foundation Workshop and then progress to the Enhancement Workshop. This qualification is perfect if you are starting out your career with children, young people or adults with learning and communication differences.

Who will benefit?

Those professionals working within the health and social care settings either in; residential care, domiciliary care, home care support, learning disability support worker, supported living support worker, 1:1 teaching assistants, nursery assistants, speech and language therapists, primary school teachers, nurses, occupational therapists, social workers and G.P's etc.

Duration of course

- This course is made up of 4 modules and can be delivered as a 2 day workshop or over a number of weeks (4 x 3 hour sessions)

Entry Requirements

- Participants need to have an understanding of early communication skills
